The Little Miss & Mister and Top Sponsor winners will ride in the parade on Sat, September 10th at 3 p.m.

Rules and requirements for Little Miss & Mister Roanoke Fall Festival:



1. We have many supporters of our festival that live right next door in other counties. Therefore, contestants do not have to be a Huntington Co. resident, but if you are the Little Miss or Mister, you are asked to honor the title and be present at the festival both Friday evening and all day Saturday.
2. Contestants must be 5-7 years old. They must have had their 5th birthday on or before the contest day, and not have turned 8 on the contest day.
3. This is a theme contest and not a dress-up event. Each child can dress in costume or their favorite character. Examples can be a fireman, a policeman, a ballerina, a princess, a cowboy or cowgirl, or simply a really cute outfit. The list is endless. NO masks or face paint please, but hats are allowed. We still want the judges to see their smiling face. Props are allowed, but only if the child can attend to them by themselves. No live animals. The children will all stay together in a designated area of the contest until the crowning is over. Parents are asked to set in the crowd and enjoy!
4. The contestants will answer four (4) questions on stage. You will receive three questions with this packet of information, and a fourth question will be taken from the information you provide on the contestant entry form.
5. Contestants will be judged on conduct, attentiveness, responsiveness to questions, poise, personality, and overall impression. The judge's decision is final. No score sheets will be available. You may contact the director for improvements or ideas for next year.
6. Each contestant is required to have at least one sponsor of \$25.00. This can be a person or a business. The top two children that have the most sponsorship monies collected is automatically a member of the court as the Top Sponsor winners and will ride in the parade! Sponsors will be recognized in the program, the newspaper, and names announced with the child's bio on contest night. Receipts will be provided as requested for tax purposes as a donation. Sponsorships will not be counted or listed unless the money is turned in with the entry form. A sponsor can give as little as \$25 or as much as they wish. The Top Sponsor winners will be counted as money received and not the amount of sponsors they have. All monies are designated for the scholarship fund and to offset costs of the contest.
7. The entry form, sponsorship form and all money collected must be turned in by the deadline listed on the front of this packet, so that we can prepare for awards and gift bags for the children.
8. Contestants must be available the whole weekend of the festival for appearances and the parade. There may be other opportunities for Little Miss and Mister Roanoke for appearances throughout the year. The new royalty will return the next year and crown the newly chosen royalty.
9. Winners will receive a crown and sash courtesy of the Roanoke Fall Festival Directors, as well as a \$50.00 scholarship towards school books. The check will be made out to the school the child attends. The Top Sponsor award winners will ride in the parade with the Little Miss and Little Mister Roanoke and the Queen's court. The winners will be expected to dress nicely for the weekend. No jeans or play clothes. Nice sundresses for girls and nice shorts and a shirt for boys. Your crown and sash is to be worn during the festival and parade.
10. Our Little Miss & Mister court will consist of Little Miss Roanoke, Little Mister Roanoke, runner-ups and top sponsors. The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd runner-ups will be chosen according to the number of children in the contest. We may or may not have all three awards. The Top Sponsor winners can also be awarded a runner-up or Little Miss or Mister award.
11. All contestants will receive a gift bag and balloon for participation.
12. Please contact the director of the event with your questions and concerns.

Contest Day Information

~On the day of the contest, your child will need to be at the Roanoke Park activity tent, no later than 4:00 p.m., dressed and ready to go for practice and photos. This will give your child a chance to walk the staging area and know where they are expected to set. All children will be in their seats and ready to go at 5:45 p.m. The Little Miss and Mister Contest will start promptly at 6:00 p.m. (Be sure your child has taken a bathroom break before 5:45 p.m.)

~All the children are expected to set in the designated area provided so they are ready to go when it is their turn. Helpers will be there to make sure they get to and from the contest area.

~Parents and guardians are expected to set in the audience and enjoy themselves! Please be sure and give us directions if there is a prop before the contest begins.

~Be sure and let the photographers do their jobs and get the photos they need, and then you and your family can enjoy your moment and get pictures.

~The judge's decision is final.

Questions that your child will be asked on stage:

1. What is your favorite food to eat?
2. Where do you and your family like to go on vacation?
3. What is your favorite thing about the Roanoke Fall Festival?
4. (Question #4 will be taken from the information you provide on the entry form).
