Information packet- Deadline to enter, June 20th

Hello! We are so happy you have decided to run for our Miss Roanoke Fall Festival Princess. There are many opportunities that await you for the future! Our new Princess will reign over the Roanoke Fall Festival, ride in surrounding parades, and represent our community in other events. Here are some details about our Princess scholarship pageant. Please read this completely and be sure and ask questions.

1. The pageant will be held on Saturday, August 6th at 5:00 p.m. in the Roanoke Elementary School in Roanoke, IN. The Princess contestants will compete in Theme Wear and Evening Wear.
2. The chosen Princess will be a part of the court that will reign over the Fall Festival on Thursday evening, September 8th, Friday, September 9th, and Saturday, September 10th. You must be able to attend all assigned events.
3. Deadline to enter will be on June 20, 2022, so we can prepare you for the pageant. A practice date will be scheduled after the June 20th entry deadline that best suit our entrants. We strive to help everyone achieve their goals in this pageant. Please ask questions!
4. The entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Roanoke Fall Festival Scholarship Pageant Committee now in affect or as announced hereafter.
5. The entrant will agree that the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the RFF Scholarship Pageant Committee, and that the decision of the judges is final.
6. The RFF Scholarship Pageant committee welcomes girls ages 8-11 to enter the pageant. You must be 8-11 years old on the day of the pageant. Note: If you will turn 12 before the date of the contest, you must enter the Duchess pageant.
7. Entrants can be from Huntington County or any surrounding county near Roanoke, IN. You will be representing the Roanoke Fall Festival.
8. An entrant is required to appear in two clothing changes during the competition:
~Theme wear outfit (this can be your choice of theme, use your imagination, no swim attire please or masks that cover your face. Examples could be but not limited to: sports outfit, going fishing with grampa, race car driver, going shopping, etc. Whatever shows off your personality).
~Party dress or long gown for the evening wear portion of the pageant.
If you have any questions at all about your clothing choices, please ask the director.
9. Each entrant is required to have at least one (1) business sponsor for \$25.00 due with your entry packet on June 20th. The contestant with the most sponsors will be a part of the court and ride in the parade on Saturday of the festival.
10. Each entrant is required to provide 4 copies of their entry form or resume on the June 20th deadline. You can use the entry form provided or you may type out your own "resume" listing your activities in a bullet list style if you wish. Please use white (no colored) paper or resume paper, with no pictures or clip art.
11. Judging will be based on the following points:

Theme wear- 40 points

Evening gown- 40 points

On stage question- 20 points (This question will be taken from the application that you submit)
(100 points total)

The judge's decision will be final. No point sheets will be passed out by the committee, but you can ask the director for tips acquired by the judge's if you wish to enter the pageant next year.

12. Scholarships for the winning entrant chosen as Princess, will be determined at a later date. Checks will be written to the school of choice.
13. The judges will choose a Princess, a possible 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up, (runners-up chosen will be according to how many entrants we have), and Top Sponsor. The Princess and the Top Sponsor will ride in the parade on Saturday.
14. All entries must be in the hand of the scholarship pageant director by June 20th.

_____ 4 x 6 or 5 x 7 photo of the contestant for the program and advertising. Your photo will be returned. This should be a head and shoulders shot only.
