68th Annual Roanoke Fall Festival, Sept 8-10, 2022

Information packet

Hello! We are so happy you have decided to run for our Miss Roanoke Fall Festival Queen. There are many opportunities that await you for the future! Our new queen will reign over the Roanoke Fall Festival, ride in surrounding parades, and represent our community in other events. If chosen, you will also have the opportunity to run for the Indiana State Festivals Association State Queen Scholarship Pageant in November and possibly earn more scholarship monies! Our rules for this scholarship pageant will mirror the rules for the ISFA Scholarship rules. Here are some details about our scholarship pageant. Please read this completely and be sure and ask questions.

1. The pageant will be held on Saturday, August 6th at 7:00 p.m. in the Roanoke Elementary School in Roanoke, IN. The schedule for the day will be determined by how many contestants we will have. Interviews will be held in the morning or early afternoon at the Roanoke Public Library on Main Street. You will then be able to go home in between and prepare for the pageant in the evening.
2. The chosen queen will reign over the Fall Festival on Thursday evening, September 8th, Friday, September 9th, and Saturday, September 10th. You must be able to attend all assigned events.
3. Deadline to enter will be on June 20, 2022, so we can prepare you for the pageant. We will have two opportunities of workshops (dates to be determined) for on stage speaking, interviews, modeling, and clothing choices in July. We strive to help everyone achieve their goals in this pageant. Please ask questions!
4. The entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Roanoke Fall Festival Scholarship Pageant Committee now in affect or as announced hereafter.
5. The entrant will agree that the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the RFF Scholarship Pageant Committee, and that the decision of the judges is final.
6. The RFF Scholarship Pageant committee welcomes young women ages 17-22 to enter the pageant. If you win our festival pageant, the entrant shall not be less than seventeen (17) years old nor more than twenty-two (22) years old on November 11, 2022 to represent the Roanoke Fall Festival in the Indiana State Festival Scholarship Pageant. (This enables a young lady to compete in the Roanoke Scholarship Queen Pageant at 16 years old, if turning 17 before November 11, 2022).
7. Entrants can be from Huntington County or any surrounding county near Roanoke, IN. You will be representing the Roanoke Fall Festival.
8. Entrant must be enrolled in high school or a high school graduate and enrolled in college by August 1st of the pageant year in which she will compete.
9. An entrant must be of good moral character and shall not have been convicted of any crimes, have not been married, or is not pregnant.
10. An entrant is required to appear in three clothing changes during the competition: opening number outfit introducing your business sponsor, business attire (to be worn for the interview and pageant), and evening gown.
11. Each entrant is required to have one (1) business sponsor for \$50.00 due with your entry packet on June 20th. You will then introduce yourself at the pageant

and have a short speech on your business sponsor. Have your business make checks payable to the Roanoke Fall Festival. We are a 501c3 and can provide receipts for businesses. Be creative with your outfit that could match your business, or it can be an outfit of your choosing. Small props with your outfit are allowed. No live animals.

12. Judging will be based on the following points:

Interview – 40 points

Introduction of your sponsor- 15 points

Business attire introducing yourself- 10 points (100 total points)

Evening gown- 25 points

On stage question- 10 points

The judge's decision will be final. No point sheets will be passed out by the committee, but you can ask the director for tips acquired by the judge's if you wish to enter the pageant next year.

13. Essay contest. This entry will be due on August 1st. Please write a short essay, 1 page or less describing our annual Roanoke Fall Festival. You can get information from any board director, an old program, or check our Facebook page Roanoke Fall Festival- Roanoke, IN for ideas. This can be hand written or typed. The winner will be announced at the Scholarship Pageant and receive a \$100.00 scholarship. Be creative. These entries will be on a table for the public to view. Please keep this entry to one 8 ½ x 11 page.

14. Scholarships for winners will be determined at a later date. Checks will be written to the college of choice.

15. The judges will choose a Queen, 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up, and possibly other runner-ups, according to the number of entrants that we have and scholarships that we have available. We will also have an Essay winner.

16. All entries must be in the hand of the scholarship pageant director by June 20th.

_____ \$50.00 sponsor check (please make sure you have the proper name of the business with this check for how they would like their name advertised).

_____ 4 x 6 or 5 x 7 photo of the contestant for the program and advertising. Your photo will be returned. This should be a head and shoulders shot only.
