

# **Miss Roanoke Fall Festival Junior Queen Scholarship Pageant: Saturday, August 6, 2022**

at Roanoke Elementary School in Roanoke, 6:00 p.m.

68<sup>th</sup> Annual Roanoke Fall Festival, Sept 8-10, 2022

## **Information packet- Deadline to enter, June 20th**

Hello! We are so happy you have decided to run for our Miss Roanoke Fall Festival Junior Queen. There are many opportunities that await you for the future! Our new Jr. Queen will reign over the Roanoke Fall Festival, ride in surrounding parades, and represent our community in other events. Here are some details about our Jr Queen scholarship pageant. Please read this completely and be sure and ask questions.

1. The pageant will be held on Saturday, August 6th at 6:00 p.m. in the Roanoke Elementary School in Roanoke, IN. The schedule for the day will be determined by how many contestants we will have. Interviews will be held in the morning or early afternoon at the Roanoke Public Library on Main Street. You will then be able to go home in between and prepare for the pageant in the evening.
2. The chosen Jr. Queen will be a part of the court that will reign over the Fall Festival on Thursday evening, September 8<sup>th</sup>, Friday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, and Saturday, September 10<sup>th</sup>. You must be able to attend all assigned events.
3. Deadline to enter will be on June 20, 2022, so we can prepare you for the pageant. We will have two opportunities of workshops (dates to be determined) for on stage speaking, interviews, modeling, and clothing choices in July. We strive to help everyone achieve their goals in this pageant. Please ask questions!
4. The entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Roanoke Fall Festival Scholarship Pageant Committee now in affect or as announced hereafter.
5. The entrant will agree that the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the RFF Scholarship Pageant Committee, and that the decision of the judges is final.
6. The RFF Scholarship Pageant committee welcomes young ladies ages 12-16 to enter the pageant. You must be 12-16 years old on the day of the pageant. Note: If you will turn 17 before the State Queen pageant in November, you will have the option to run for Queen.
7. Entrants can be from Huntington County or any surrounding county near Roanoke, IN. You will be representing the Roanoke Fall Festival.
8. An entrant must be of good moral character and shall not have been convicted of any crimes, have not been married, or is not pregnant.
9. An entrant is required to appear in three clothing changes during the competition:
  - ~Theme wear outfit (this can be your choice of theme, use your imagination, no swim attire please or masks that cover your face. Examples could be but not limited to: sports outfit, going fishing with grampa, race car driver, going shopping, etc. Whatever shows off your personality).
  - ~Interview outfit, such as a Sunday dress or dress pants (to be worn for the afternoon interview and pageant).
  - ~Party dress or long gown for the evening wear portion of the pageant.If you have any questions at all about your clothing choices, please ask the director!

10. Each entrant is required to have at least one (1) business sponsor for \$25.00 due with your entry packet on June 20<sup>th</sup>. The contestant with the most sponsors will be a part of the court and ride in the parade on Saturday of the festival.
11. Each entrant is required to provide 4 copies of their entry form or resume on the June 20<sup>th</sup> deadline. You can use the entry form provided or you may type out your own "resume" listing your activities in a bullet list style if you wish. Please use white (no colored) paper or resume paper, with no pictures or clip art.
12. Judging will be based on the following points:
  - Interview – 40 points
  - Theme wear- 15 points
  - Interview outfit introducing yourself- 10 points
  - Evening gown- 25 points
  - On stage question- 10 points

(100 total points)

The judge's decision will be final. No point sheets will be passed out by the committee, but you can ask the director for tips acquired by the judge's if you wish to enter the pageant next year.
13. Scholarships for the winning entrant chosen as Jr. Queen, will be determined at a later date. Checks will be written to the school of choice.
14. The judges will choose a Jr. Queen, a possible 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up, 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up, (runners-up chosen will be according to how many entrants we have), Theme wear winner, and Top Sponsor. The Jr. Queen and the Top Sponsor will ride in the parade on Saturday.
15. All entries must be in the hand of the scholarship pageant director by June 20<sup>th</sup>.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 4 x 6 or 5 x 7 photo of the contestant for the program and advertising. Your photo will be returned. This should be a head and shoulders shot only.
