Deadline to enter your name as a contestant, Friday June 21st

Hello! We are so happy you have decided to run for our Miss Roanoke Fall Festival Princess. There are many opportunities that await you for the future! Our new Princess will reign over the Roanoke Fall Festival, ride in surrounding parades, and represent our community in other events. Here are some details about our Princess scholarship program. Please read this completely and be sure and ask questions.

1. The scholarship program will be held on Saturday, August 3rd at 2:00 p.m. in the Roanoke Elementary School in Roanoke, IN. The Princess contestants will compete in Theme Wear and Evening Wear, and an onstage question.
2. The chosen Princess will be a part of the court that will reign over the Fall Festival on Thursday evening, September 5th, Friday, September 6th, and Saturday, September 7th. Our Princess must be able to attend all assigned events.
3. The deadline to enter will be on Friday, June 21, 2024, by midnight, so we can prepare for the first practice. Please email, text, or call the director with your intent to compete. We only need a name at this point.
4. The entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Roanoke Fall Festival Scholarship Program Committee now in effect or as announced hereafter.
5. The entrant will agree that the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the RFF Scholarship Program Committee, and that the decision of the judges is final.
6. The RFF Scholarship Program committee welcomes girls ages 8-11 to enter. You must be 8-11 years old on the day of the program. Note: If you turn 12 before the date of the program, you must enter the Junior Queen program.
7. Entrants can be from Huntington County or any surrounding county near Roanoke, IN. You will be representing the Roanoke Fall Festival.
8. An entrant is required to appear in two clothing changes during the competition:
~Theme wear outfit (this can be your choice of theme, use your imagination, no swim attire please or masks that cover your face. Examples could be but not limited to: sports outfit, going fishing with grampa, race car driver, going shopping, fall festival theme which is “Celebrate the 70’s”, etc. Whatever shows off your personality).
~Party dress or long gown for the evening wear portion of the program.
If you have any questions at all about your clothing choices, please ask the director.
9. Each entrant is required to have at least one (1) sponsor for \$25.00 due with your entry packet at the first practice. The contestant with the most sponsorship money collected will be awarded the Top Sponsor, and ride in the parade on Saturday of the festival. Please print exactly on the form provided how your sponsor(s) want to be listed in our program and advertisement. Sponsorships can be in any dollar amount. Be especially mindful of proper business names.

10. Each entrant is required to provide 4 copies of their one-page entry form or resume at the first practice (deadline). You can use the entry form provided or you may type out your own "resume" listing your activities in a bullet list style if you wish. Please use white (no colored) paper or resume paper, with no pictures or clip art. Also, use the same format as listed. Please include the first and last names of parents. If parent(s) live separately, please indicate how you would prefer them to be listed. Signatures are required for both the contestant and a parent or legal guardian. The judges will see this form so please write neatly. Please let us know if you need help with printing. We are happy to accept these via email to help you out.
11. Judging will be based on the following points:

Theme wear- 40 points
Evening wear- 40 points
On stage question- 20 points
(100 points total)

The judge's decision will be final. No point sheets will be passed out by the committee, but you can ask the director for tips acquired by the judges if you wish to enter the program next year.

12. A \$100.00 Scholarship will be presented to the contestant chosen as Princess. Checks will be written to the school of choice.
13. The judges will choose a Princess, runners up (the number of runners-up chosen will be according to how many entrants we have), a Theme Wear winner, and a Top Sponsor. The Princess and the Top Sponsor will ride in the parade on Saturday of the festival.
14. If chosen Roanoke Princess, the dress code for events is as follows: no torn jeans or flip flops, no backless dresses or short shirts, no shirts with advertising (festival shirt is approved). We ask that you wear your crown and sash at all events. Thank you for putting your best foot forward!
15. All entries must be in the hands of the scholarship program director by the first practice.

Note: We will have a call out meeting on Monday, May 6 at 6:00 p.m. Please be sure and attend this informational meeting. Checklist for entries due June 24th (the first practice):

_____ 4 copies of your one-page application (or) resumé. Type or print neatly and signed.

_____ Your sponsor form with at least a \$25 sponsor listed. (Please make sure you have the proper name of the businesses or individuals listed with how they would like their name to be advertised). Include all money collected.

_____ 4 x 6 photo of the contestant for the program and advertising. Your photo will be returned. This should be a head and shoulders shot only. It is encouraged to email the director with your photo, but this is not required.

Summer Schedule: (VIP is Very Important Practice or event!)

Although we don't call our meetings "mandatory", it is in your best interest to attend all the practices and the Queen's Tea. Attendance will be taken. We worked hard to set a schedule early in the year so you can plan accordingly. We will keep practicing to one hour.

Monday, May 6th at 6:00 p.m. Call out meeting at Seminary Church in Roanoke. 285 Seminary Street, Roanoke, IN 46783.

VIP! Friday, June 21st. Deadline to enter the Princess Scholarship Program by midnight. You must text or email the director with your intention to run so we can prepare for the first practice. All we need on this day is your name.

Monday, June 24th. 1st practice at Seminary Church, Roanoke. 6 p.m. Resumes, sponsorship list and money, and pictures are due at this first practice. Dress is casual.

VIP! Sunday, July 14th- Queen's Tea. 1 p.m. at The Gathering Place, 547 Guilford Street in Huntington. This is a fun day to celebrate our royalty and visit with our queens for tips. Food will be served. Sundress, dress, or dress slacks are required. We will have guests and take pictures!

Monday, July 22nd- 2nd practice at Seminary Church. 6 p.m. Dress is casual.

VIP! Monday, July 29th- final practice at Seminary Church. 6 p.m. This is your last practice before program day! Please attend. Casual dress but bring the shoes you will compete in for practice if needed.

Saturday, August 3rd. Princess Scholarship Program day! Arrive no later than 1:00 p.m. It's preferred you arrive in your theme wear outfit, but if you cannot do that, time will be allowed for dressing. We would also like you to "walk the triangle since the gym will be different than our practice areas. No parents or friends are allowed in the dressing room except to help you bring in your items. Please have everything marked with your name on it. Program will start at 2 p.m. If you are chosen as the Princess, you are required to return that evening for the Queen Scholarship Program for pictures. We would also love to see the rest of the court as well! Please wear your gowns. Re-entry tickets will be given out to family and friends to return that evening at no charge.
