

**Miss Roanoke Fall Festival Princess**  
**Scholarship Program: Saturday, August 5, 2023**  
at Roanoke Elementary School in Roanoke, 5:00 p.m.  
69<sup>th</sup> Annual Roanoke Fall Festival, Sept 7-9, 2023

**Information packet- Deadline to enter, Fri. June 23rd**

Hello! We are so happy you have decided to run for our Miss Roanoke Fall Festival Princess. There are many opportunities that await you for the future! Our new Princess will reign over the Roanoke Fall Festival, ride in surrounding parades, and represent our community in other events. Here are some details about our Princess scholarship program. Please read this completely and be sure and ask questions.

1. The scholarship program will be held on Saturday, August 5th at 5:00 p.m. in the Roanoke Elementary School in Roanoke, IN. The Princess contestants will compete in Theme Wear and Evening Wear.
2. The chosen Princess will be a part of the court that will reign over the Fall Festival on Thursday evening, September 7<sup>th</sup>, Friday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, and Saturday, September 9<sup>th</sup>. You must be able to attend all assigned events.
3. Deadline to enter will be on June 23, 2023, so we can prepare you for the scholarship program. A practice date will be scheduled after the June 23rd entry deadline. We strive to help everyone achieve their goals in this program. Please ask questions!
4. The entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Roanoke Fall Festival Scholarship Program Committee now in affect or as announced hereafter.
5. The entrant will agree that the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the RFF Scholarship Program Committee, and that the decision of the judges is final.
6. The RFF Scholarship Program committee welcomes girls ages 8-11 to enter. You must be 8-11 years old on the day of the program. Note: If you will turn 12 before the date of the program, you must enter the Junior Queen program.
7. Entrants can be from Huntington County or any surrounding county near Roanoke, IN. You will be representing the Roanoke Fall Festival.
8. An entrant is required to appear in two clothing changes during the competition:  
~Theme wear outfit (this can be your choice of theme, use your imagination, no swim attire please or masks that cover your face. Examples could be but not limited to: sports outfit, going fishing with grampa, race car driver, going shopping, etc. Whatever shows off your personality).  
~Party dress or long gown for the evening wear portion of the program.  
If you have any questions at all about your clothing choices, please ask the director.
9. Each entrant is required to have at least one (1) sponsor for \$25.00 due with your entry packet on June 23rd. The contestant with the most sponsorship money collected will be awarded the Top Sponsor, and ride in the parade on Saturday of the festival. Please print exactly how your sponsor(s) want to be listed in our program and advertisement. Sponsorships can be in any dollar amount.
10. Each entrant is required to provide 4 copies of their entry form or resume on the June 23rd deadline. You can use the entry form provided or you may type out your own "resume" listing your activities in a bullet list style if you wish. Please use white (no colored) paper or resume paper, with no pictures or clip art. Also,

use the same format as listed. Please include first and last names of parents. If parent(s) live separately, please indicate how you would prefer them to be listed. The judges will see this form so please write neatly.

11. Judging will be based on the following points:

Theme wear- 40 points

Evening wear- 40 points

On stage question- 20 points (This question will be taken from the application that you submit.)

(100 points total)

The judge's decision will be final. No point sheets will be passed out by the committee, but you can ask the director for tips acquired by the judges if you wish to enter the program next year.

12. A \$100.00 Scholarship will be presented to the contestant chosen as Princess. Checks will be written to the school of choice.

13. The judges will choose a Princess, a possible 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up, 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up, (runners-up chosen will be according to how many entrants we have), and Top Sponsor. The Princess and the Top Sponsor will ride in the parade on Saturday of the festival.

14. If chosen Roanoke Princess, the dress code for events is as follows: no torn jeans or flip flops, no backless dresses or short shirts, No shirts with advertising. We ask that you wear your crown and sash at all events.

15. All entries must be in the hand of the scholarship program director by June 23rd.

\_\_\_\_\_ Your sponsor form with at least a \$25 sponsor listed. (Please make sure you have the proper name of the businesses or individuals listed with how they would like their name to be advertised). Include all money collected.

\_\_\_\_\_ 4 x 6 or 5 x 7 photo of the contestant for the program and advertising. Your photo will be returned. This should be a head and shoulders shot only.
